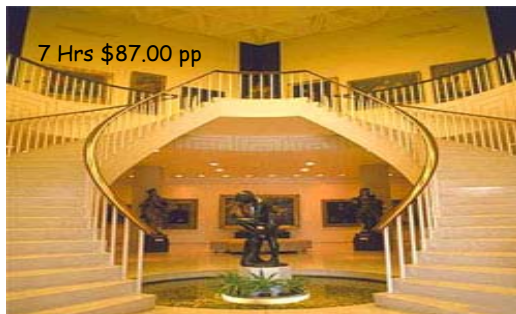


Perla del Sur Ponce City Tour

We combine the El Yunque Rain Forest and one of the best swimming beaches in Puerto Rico, all together for you in this full day tour!

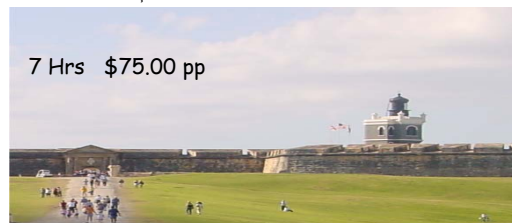
Camuy Caves Arecibo Observatory

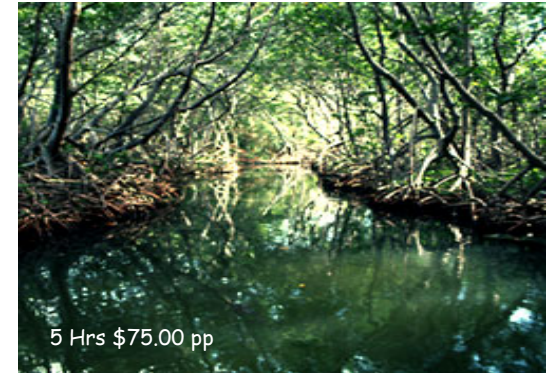


Old San Juan Bacardi Rum Factory
